



# At St Mary's we've outlawed bullying as it has no place in our school!

We want all of our children to be happy, safe & to reach their full & amazing potential!





In order for St Mary's to be a 'Bully Free Zone' we work hard to ensure that this is really the case! Bullying is covered as part of the Establishment Phase at the beginning of the year as well as in assemblies in order that children are very clear about what *it* 

is, what it isn't & what to do if it happens. This is then picked up on in classes by teachers as part of PSHE, Circle Time activities & P4C.

Because our underlying ethos is Christian, we often refer back to the teachings of Jesus to "treat others as you yourself would like to be treated!" (Luke 6:31) & try to ensure that children are taught how to respect & relate to each other in the most positive ways possible.



### What is Bullying?

Bullying is when one child, or a group of children, keeps on trying to make somebody else feel sad, lonely or scared.

Bullying can take many different forms, such as:

- Physical: e.g. kicking, hitting and damaging belongings;
- Verbal: e.g. name calling, taunting, threats and making offensive remarks;
- Indirect: e.g. spreading nasty stories about someone, gossiping and leaving someone out;
- Cyber: sending nasty emails, messages using social media, texts or making upsetting phone calls.

Bullying is *intentional* (not an accident) where a bully hurts someone on purpose & is *repetitive*. This means that the bully hurts someone over & over again — it doesn't just happen once. Bullying is where one person acts like they have more power than another & does whatever they can to hurt

Bullying is NOT when you have a one off argument or say something unkind. Bullying is done on purpose over and over again, i.e. they MEAN IT

& REPEAT IT!

If someone is trying to make you feel bad so that most of the time you are frightened or sad,

#### just remember to tell!

When someone is hurting you day after day and whatever you do they just won't go away, just remember to tell!
